RESOLUTION TO ADOPT MILLAGE BALLOT LANGUAGE
Washington Township, Gratiot County

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Washington Township wishes to provide Fire and Rescue protection; and

WHEREAS, townships may provide Fire and Rescue protection, as authorized by Public Act 33 of 1951, MCL 41.801 et, seq and

WHEREAS, township may impose and levy ad valorem taxes to finance lawful public services, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Washington Township wishes to levy 1.10 mills to provide Fire and Rescue Protection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Board of Washington Township, Gratiot County, Michigan approves the following millage ballot question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the August 2, 2016, election ballot:

Shall Washington Township, Gratiot County, Michigan impose a renewal of up to 1.10 mills (\$1.10 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX Sec 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for 5 years, 2017 through 2021 inclusive, for the purpose of Fire and Rescue Protection, which 1.10 mills will raise an estimated \$28,600 in the first year.





Aug 2, 2016 Shall Washington Township, Gratiot County, Michigan impose a renewal of up to 1.10 mills (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of TV) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX Sec 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for 5 years, 2017 through 2021 inclusive, for the purpose of Fire and Rescue Protection, which 1.10 mills will raise an estimated \$28,600 in the first year.
