RESOLUTION: Consolidate School Election 05.06.2025

WHEREAS, St. Johns School District has called an election to be held on May 6th, 2025. There are 6 registered voters for that school district in the Jurisdiction of Fulton Township. There are no other federal or state issues on the ballot for this jurisdiction.

WHEREAS, Act 116 of 1954 section 168.659 allows for consolidation of election precincts provided a resolution is adopted at a minimum of 60 days before the election.

WHEREAS, Fulton Township Clerk has requested those school district voters be consolidated with voters in Washington Township. Washington Township has consented to manage those voters for this one election, with the Fulton Township Clerk issuing their own absentee ballots.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Washington Township Election Commission agrees to adopt this resolution to consolidate this election as agreed upon and stated above.
